Last month we welcomed Myer Rath, a senior at Lake Park High School as she fulfills her obligation of volunteer hours for the National Honor Society.



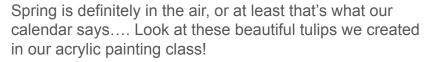














The Science of Making Butter
